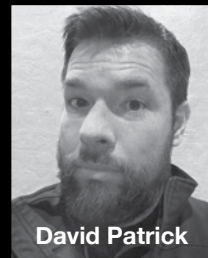

#### 3140 McGavock Pike, Nashville, TN 37214

From Trevecca, turn RIGHT onto Murfreesboro Road. After approximately ½ mile turn LEFT onto Fesslers Lane. Fesslers will dead end into Lebanon Road. Turn RIGHT onto Lebanon Road. Stay on Lebanon rd approximately 4 miles. Turn LEFT onto McGavock Pike. Park & golf course will be on your left after approximately 1.3 miles.

### MEN'S & WOMEN'S BASKETBALL CO-ED SOFTBALL

#### Donelson Christian Academy

#### 300 Danyacrest Drive, Nashville, TN 37214

From Trevecca, turn RIGHT on Murfreesboro Road to Fesslers Lane. Take a LEFT on Fesslers Lane until it dead-ends into Lebanon Road. Take a RIGHT onto Lebanon Road and continue 6.4 miles to Danyacrest Rd. (You will pass Briley Parkway, pass through Donelson, and you are close when you pass the YMCA on the right.) Turn LEFT onto Danyacrest and continue straight to DCA.

### SKATEBOARDING

#### 601 4th Avenue South, Nashville, TN 37203

From Trevecca, turn LEFT onto Murfreesboro Road. Head north-west and continue onto Lafayette St. Take a slight right onto 5th Ave S. Turn right onto Lea Ave. Turn right onto 4th Ave S. Rockettown will be on the right.

### SWIMMING

#### Centennial SportsPlex

#### 222 25th Avenue North, Nashville, TN 37203

From Trevecca, turn LEFT onto Murfreesboro Road. Murfreesboro Road will dead end into 8th Avenue. Veer RIGHT onto 8th Avenue. (Be aware of heavy construction in this area.) Turn LEFT at Broadway. After you cross the interstate, stay to your RIGHT at the split - the road becomes West End Ave. Turn RIGHT at 24th Ave, then make an almost immediate LEFT on Elliston Place. Turn RIGHT on 25th Ave. Centennial SportsPlex will be on your right.
